George went on about the good luck he has had using the new Seg-Easy Sled show here ar two round 16 segment frames, now looking for a good subject to fill them.

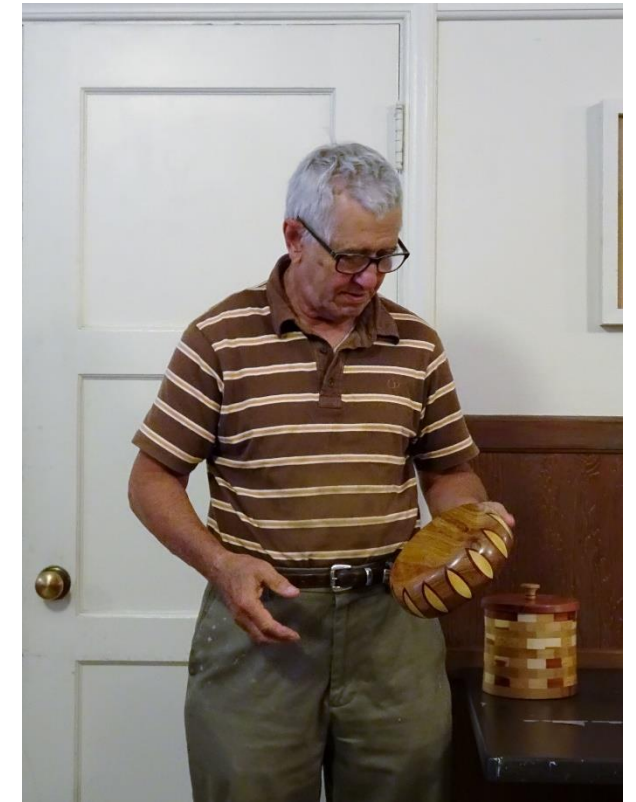
